This is a Welsh Government driven project that aims to raise the awareness of children, young people and adults about the issues around safety, about healthy relationships and also gender equality. Each workshop is age appropriate and is designed to promote peer discussion. The sessions are delivered by qualified, experienced teachers alongside our own teachers. It is part of the Personal and Social Educational curriculum that we have to deliver.
