Dog Control Public Spaces Protection Order

Flintshire County Council have requested that we share the following information with you:

As from Friday the 20th October, dog owners must have a means on their person to collect dog waste, and remove dog waste immediately from all public locations, dogs must be on a lead on public land where a dog is considered to be out of control or causing alarm and distress. They are also not permitted on **school grounds**, children's play areas, marked sports pitches and playing area of specific sporting or recreational facilities. and on playing areas of marked sports pitches. They are permitted in cemeteries if they are on a lead.
