Federation Update:

Before half term, pupils from both schools voted to name our federation. You will be pleased to know that we have a winner! We will be called **The Bryniau Clwyd Federation. (The Clwydian Hills Federation)**

From Monday 7th June 2021, our schools were formally federated and the first meeting of our joint Governing Body will take place this week. Both Ysgol Yr Esgob and Ysgol Licswm retain their own school name and identity and separate budgets. Leavers Service – Friday 16th July

With the easing of the current Covid restrictions in Wales we would like to go ahead and plan the leavers service for our year 6 children. This will have to be held outdoors, with social distancing, and limited to 30 adults. We would therefore like to invite two adults per year 6 child to come to school on Friday 16th July at 10.00am to help us mark this special occasion for our year 6 children. Please log on to School Gateway and provide us with the name of the adult/s who will be attending. If restrictions are eased and we are able to increase the numbers we will of course let you know. Please also note that this will only go ahead if the restrictions remain the same.

Sports Day – Year 3, 4, 5 & 6 Pupils

We are planning to hold Sports Day for **KS2 on Friday 25th June** (weather permitting). Year 3 & 4 will be from 9.30am to 10.30am and Year 5 & 6 will be 10.45am to 11.45am. The current Covid restrictions allow 30 adults to be outdoors, socially distanced. As we are a small school we would like to take advantage of this and offer you the opportunity for 1 adult to come in and support each child as they compete in their races. Most schools are doing this as a closed event this year but if we manage to keep numbers to 30 and socially distance on site we are happy for this to go ahead.

Please inform us on School Gateway no later than 21st June who will be attending. **Please note that this is invitation only for one person per child. We must not exceed this number.** On the day please bring your own pen as you will need to sign in for Track and Trace purposes.

Kingswood, Colomendy Day Visit:

On Monday 12th July we are taking pupils in Year 3 to 6 on an outdoor day adventure visit to Kingswood in Colomendy. We will be leaving school at 9.00am and returning by 5.00pm. Children will need to wear suitable outdoor clothing, a waterproof coat and trainers, bring a packed lunch and drinks (no glass bottles please). If the weather is warm, please ensure that your child has sun cream applied in the morning and a sun hat. Payment can be made in instalments - £10.40 by 18th June, £20.00 by 2nd July and £20.00 by the 9th July. Full payment must be made by 9th July.

Sun Cream: Please ensure that your child has sun cream applied before they come into school as we are outside a lot during the school day. Sun hats would also be a good idea.

Clwb Bwthyn Bach:

CBB runs wrap around care from 11.30-3.00pm for children 2.5 years old up to nursery age. It also runs an after school club until 6.00pm. This is essential for many of our working parents and it is helping our school to grow because it makes us attractive to prospective parents.
